

Ole Tunold, PsyD, MTM

Ole Tunold is Secretary General of the Norwegian Psychological Association since 2008 - a non political, full time CEO position. He is elected Vice President of EFPA since 2019 and served as a Board member of IAAP for 2014 to 2022.

Over the years he has taken part in several of EFPA's temporary bodies.



Ole Tunold graduated as a psychologist from the University of Oslo and received a master's degree in technology management from the Norwegian University of Science and Technology. He worked as an organizational psychologist for an international management consulting company. He later worked as a hospital director before and after a major restructuring of the Norwegian health services. More recently, Ole Tunold has lived and worked abroad, in Russia and France, holding temporary positions as special advisor and diplomat. His research work has been with the OECD Halden Reactor Project and the research institute of the Norwegian Medical Association. Before entering his university studies, Ole Tunold served for several years as an operational officer in the Royal Norwegian Air force.
